BASIC AUDIT REPORT

Erie County Port Authority Erie County 247 Columbus Avenue Sandusky, Ohio 44870

We have completed certain procedures in accordance with Ohio Rev. Code Section 117.01(G) to the accounting records and related documents of Erie County Port Authority, Erie County, Ohio, (the Port Authority) for the years ended December 31, 2023 and 2022.

Our procedures were designed solely to satisfy the audit requirements of Ohio Rev. Code Section 117.11(A). Because our procedures were not designed to opine on the Port Authority's financial statements, we did not follow *generally accepted auditing standards*. We do not provide any assurance on the Port Authority's financial statements, transactions or balances for the years ended December 31, 2023 and 2022.

The Port Authority's management is responsible for preparing and maintaining its accounting records and related documents. Our responsibility under Ohio Rev. Code Section 117.11(A) is to examine, analyze and inspect these records and documents.

Based on the results of our procedures, we found the following significant compliance or accounting issue to report.

Current Year Observation

The Port Authority did not file its 2023 annual report timely. **Ohio Rev. Code § 117.38** provides that each public office, other than a state agency, shall file a financial report for each fiscal year. The report shall be certified by the proper officer or board and filed with the auditor of state within sixty days after the close of the fiscal year. At the time the report is filed with the auditor of state, the chief fiscal officer shall publish notice in a newspaper published in the taxing district. The notice shall state the financial report has been completed by the public office and is available for public inspection at the office of the chief fiscal officer.

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The Port Authority did not file the 2023 annual report until March 8, 2024. Failure to file by the required date could result in penalties of \$25 per day up to maximum of \$750. The Port Authority should take the necessary steps to ensure the financial report is prepared completely in accordance with Auditor of State Bulletin 2015-007 and filed within the sixty day time frame.
