We have performed the procedures enumerated below on Lawrence E. Daykin's (the Provider) compliance with the requirements of the Medicaid Promoting Interoperability Program for the year ended December 31, 2019. The Provider is responsible for compliance with applicable laws and regulations of the Medicaid Promoting Interoperability Program.

The Ohio Department of Medicaid (Department) has agreed to and acknowledged that the procedures performed are appropriate to meet the intended purpose of reviewing eligible providers awarded Medicaid Provider Incentive Program monies. No other party acknowledged the appropriateness of the procedures. This report may not be suitable for any other purpose. The procedures performed may not address all the items of interest to a user of this report and may not meet the needs of all users of this report and, as such, users are responsible for determining whether the procedures performed are appropriate for their purposes. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of the Department. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

The procedures and the associated findings are as follows:

1. We obtained the Provider's encounters during the patient volume attestation period, performed a duplicate check and found none, and confirmed that the encounters included multiple payer sources. We calculated the Medicaid patient volume and the Provider met the 30 percent requirement.
2. We compared supporting documentation to the criteria for meaningful use (MU) Objective 1 and the system generated dashboard to the applicable criteria and to the summaries for MU Objectives 2 and 4 through 7 and the clinical quality measures (CQMs). We confirmed that the supporting documentation and dashboards indicated that these objectives and the minimum measures were met. We noted no variances greater than 10 percentage points between these reports.

We were engaged by the Department to perform this agreed-upon procedures engagement and conducted our engagement in accordance with attestation standards established by the AICPA. We were not engaged to and did not conduct an examination or review engagement, the objective of which would be the expression of an opinion or conclusion, respectively, on the Provider's compliance with applicable laws and regulations of the Medicaid Promoting Interoperability Program. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion or conclusion. Had we performed additional procedures, other matters might have come to our attention that would have been reported to you.
